

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROSSER

BY-LAW NO. 13-09

Being a By-Law to amend the ward system established under By-law 4-02 for the purpose of electing Municipal Councillors

WHEREAS subsection 87(1) of The Municipal Act provides as follows:

“Every member of a council is to be elected by a vote of the electors of the whole municipality unless the council by by-law provides that the councillors are to be elected on the basis of wards.”;

AND WHEREAS subsection 88(a) provides as follows:

“must try to achieve an approximately equal number of residents in each ward”;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and desirable to amend the wards of the Rural Municipality of Rosser to achieve wards that reflect approximately equal number of residents in each ward;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Rosser enacts as follows:

1. That the Rural Municipality of Rosser be divided into four Wards, as per attached Schedule “A”.
2. That the Four Wards be named as follows:
 - 1) Ward 1,
 - 2) Ward 2,
 - 3) Ward 3,
 - 4) Ward 4.
3. That this by-law takes effect at the next general election.
